

August 2024 Vigil for Peace –Timetable

August 5-8 the Community of Sant'Egidio and friends gather for three consecutive days in a Vigil to remember the victims – children, women, men – of the atomic bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. Due to the different time zones the Vigil begins on Monday, August 5 at 7 pm In New York (Tuesday, August 6 at 8 AM in Japan) and concludes on Thursday, August 8 at 10 pm in New York (Thursday, August 9 at 11 AM in Japan)

The Vigil primarily is silent – our being stilled and at rest in the presence of God, Father and Son Jesus and Holy Spirit. It is a Christian moment open to all. It will follow an hourly sequence:

- at the beginning of each hour we light a candle, share a reading of Holy Scriptures and a brief homily
- at the first quarter, we recall silently the atomic devastation;
- at the half hour we invite all present to remember the suffering victims of violence, of war, and of the conflicts still raging, the Communities of Sant'Egidio around the world and all the peacemakers;
- At the three quarters we read the prayers shared in person and online.

Each hour begins with a reading from Holy Scripture followed by the expression:

*May the Lord give us
the grace to listen and to live
this word that we received “*

In the first quarter, we recall the atomic devastation and remember the children, women, and men killed in that moment and in the bombing of Nagasaki three days later. At this time we also pray with and for all countries in which it is 8:15 in the morning, with the suffering victims of violence, of war, and of the conflicts still raging ([here](#).) and all Communities of Sant'Egidio.
