

Consultative Sant'Egidio Meeting

Tumaini Consensus

From 12th to 14th August 2024 in Rome, at the Community of Sant'Egidio, at the proposal of the special envoy of the Government of South Sudan, a delegation of the SSOMA Leadership Council led by General Thomas Cirillo and the delegation of the South Sudanese Government met at the presence of representatives of the Kenyan Government and the Community of Sant'Egidio.

The meeting, the first in many months between the South Sudanese government and the SSOMA LC, has been an opportunity to present the progress of Tumaini initiative as an ongoing inclusive, open process aimed to galvanize sustainable, fair and genuine peace settlement by the South Sudanese people.

The meeting noted with satisfaction the open, genuine discussion and the parties' desire to continue on the path of political dialogue as the only solution to the country's political crisis, and to foster healing among the South Sudanese people.

The meeting further underscored the importance of addressing the divergent positions through political compromise and consultation.

The Mediation teams remain available to receive from SSOMA LC their proposals for the common good of all South Sudanese people.
